MCO is proud to offer the MCO Scholarship Program. This program will offer fifteen \$750 grants per year to children of MCO members who are entering college.

Eligibility

- Child, stepchild, or adopted child of an MCO member in good standing according to the MCO bylaws.
- Graduate from a high school or G.E.D. program by August 2025 and be enrolled as a college freshman by the fall semester of 2025, or
- Be returning to an accredited college or university as a sophomore, junior or senior as of the fall semester 2025; or attending an accredited community college as of the fall semester 2025.
- Winners from previous years will not be considered.

Application Instructions

- Complete sections 1, 2, 3, 5, 6 and 7 (incomplete applications will be disqualified). Have a school official fill out section 4.
- Submit a transcript, letter of recommendation and ACT or SAT scores (see page 4).
- Submit a typed 500-word essay describing your general knowledge of MCO and its importance to the members. Also include a brief paragraph on your career goals.
